

We Need Your Help



Dr. Benjamin F. Stephenson, founder of the Grand Army of the Republic and provisional commander-inchief, April 6, 1866 to November 21, 1866. Born in Wayne County, III, October 3, 1823, his father being a native of South Carolina and his mother a native of North Carolina.

April 6, 1866, in Decatur, III, there was formed post No. 1 of the Grand Army of the Republic with 12 charter members. Dr. Stephenson then worked enthusiastically to promote the formation of more posts, often neglecting his own personal interests.

He died at Rock Creek, Menard County, III, August 30, 1871, in the 48th year and was buried in the cemetery there. August 29, 1882, the body was removed to the Soldiers Plot in Rose Hill Cemetery, Petersburg, III
